

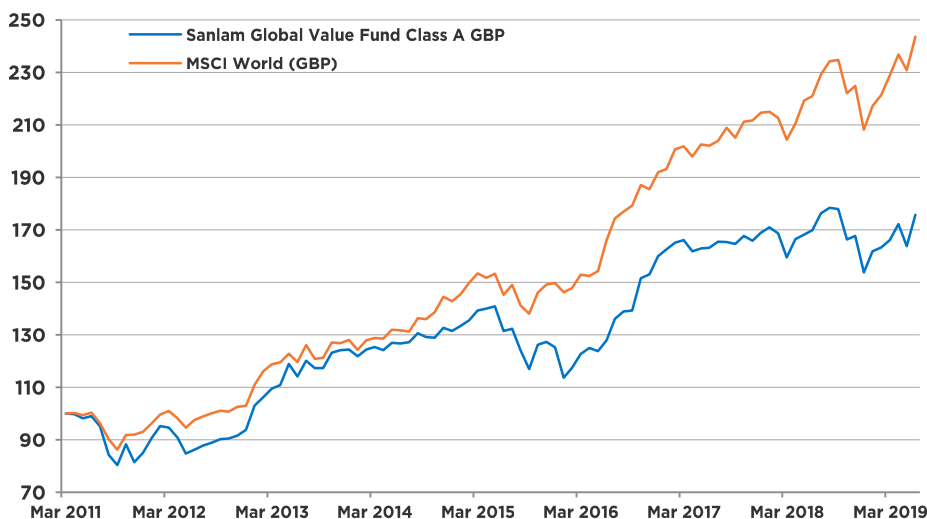
# Sanlam Global Value Fund

## Overview

The fund aims to deliver attractive real returns, and superior investment returns to the wider equity market over time. The focus is on strong companies with above average cash returns on capital that are trading at a significant discount to their intrinsic value.

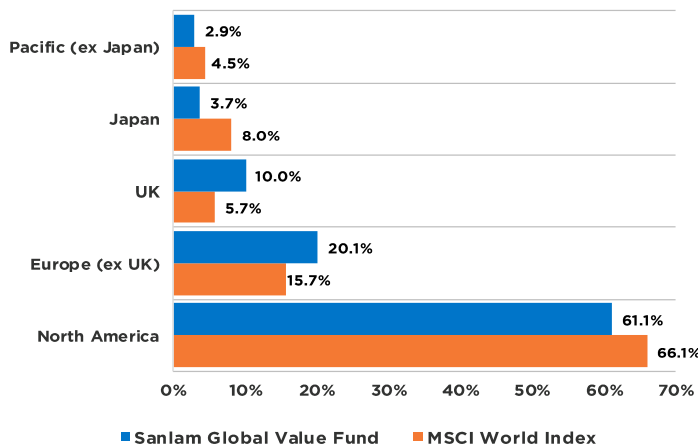

## Monthly commentary

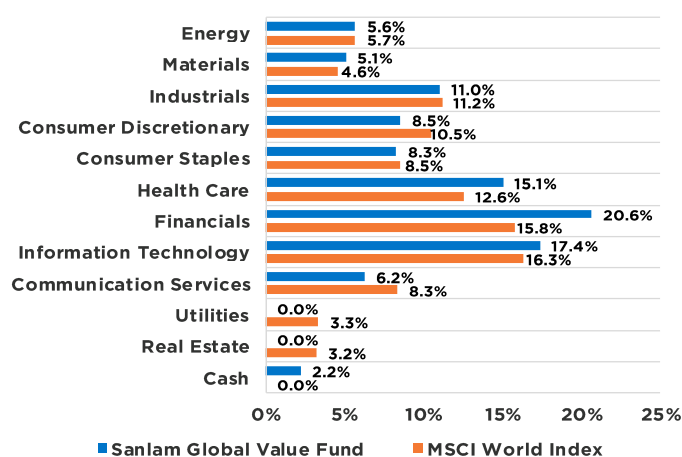
June has been a very important month for the evolution of the fund as we brought it a step closer to what we would consider a world class value portfolio. More precisely, we continued shifting the portfolio toward a better risk-reward proposition that embodies our stated philosophy and process. We are selecting companies that are strictly unloved, under-researched, or under-appreciated, adhering to our criteria of 1) minimum double digit annual returns, 2) asymmetric risk profile, and 3) downside protection. Our newly introduced checklist has already proven its worth, informing a number of weighing decisions, ensuring strict adherence to our principles and resonating very well with colleagues and peers. New notable investments were Corteva, Spirit Aerosystems and Delphi Technologies, while we exited our positions in Gilead Sciences, Malaysia Airports, ESR-REIT and Norwegian Cruise Lines.

Delphi Technologies is one of the primary US auto suppliers, specialising in both internal combustion and EV/Hybrid components. The company benefits from structural tailwinds in the form of higher efficiency, regulation and the rise EV/Hybrid, which will increase Delphi's content per vehicle by a factor of five times over the decade. Just like the rest of the auto suppliers or OEMs, Delphi is trading on rock bottom multiples (4x P/E). We feel the weakness in the Auto cycle is more than priced into the stock and we are being offered a decent business, at bargain valuations. We see more than 100% upside. As patient, long term investors we do not typically expect immediate gratification, but we are very pleased that the changes we implemented in June have had an instant benefit to performance. The fund gained 8.2% in USD terms, significantly outperforming the broader equity market (6.6%). Our most notable contributors were Allergan, Western Digital, Samsung, Exor and Delphi. Recent investments like Tenaris, Adecco, Corteva, and Berkshire Hathaway further added to performance. I have written before how our companies by the virtue of being cheap with valuable assets having attracted corporate actions in the past. We have had three takeovers and two spinoffs in the past six months alone. In June it was Allergan's turn, which was approached by AbbVie and caused the stock to jump 40%. The stock is now trading close to our target price and a 10% discount to the bid price – we are looking to exit this position in due course.
